More info will be made available as soon as the drawing date has been set!

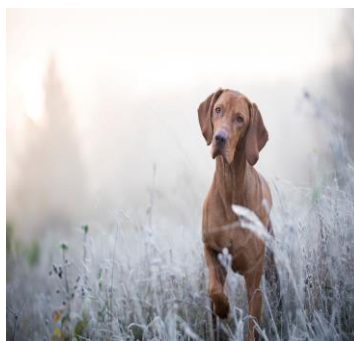
Trainings/Classes:
